Summary of Student Feedback for the Academic Year 2023-24

Strengths:

- 1. Faculty and Teaching Quality: Students appreciated the dedication and honesty of the teachers, recognizing their efforts in creating a positive learning environment.
- 2. Learning Opportunities: Many students acknowledged the institution's efforts to provide opportunities for learning and growth, including internships, student exchanges, and field visits.
- 3. **Overall Satisfaction:** General feedback included terms like "Very good," "Great," and "Good," reflecting a positive sentiment toward the institution.

Areas for Improvement:

1. Infrastructure:

- Classroom Furniture: Poor quality benches and chairs, especially during exams, caused discomfort for students. Upgraded furniture is necessary.
- o **Technology in Classrooms:** Suggestions to install projectors and better facilities to enhance learning, particularly in subjects like Biology.
- o Notice Board System: A creative and engaging notice board system was recommended to improve information dissemination.

2. Professional Opportunities:

 Stronger focus on internships, student exchanges, field visits, and trips to better align with career development and skill enhancement.

3. Administrative Behaviour:

 Students reported issues with rude behaviour from clerks and emphasized the need for a more supportive administrative team.

4. General Improvements:

- The college atmosphere should feel more dynamic and aligned with a true collegiate experience.
- o Timely communication of notices in the college group needs attention.

Additional Comments:

Students expressed gratitude for the feedback process, highlighting its importance in fostering continuous improvement.
