Minutes of the first meeting of IQAC for the year 2019-20 conducted on July 15, 2019.

The meeting took place on the scheduled date and time in the Principal's office.

- 1. The Coordinator, Mr Parshant Sethi brought to light the fact that these days, New Education Policy is being discussed at length and keeping in mind this major expected change in the present education system, the need of the hour is to apprise the institutions in the city of the expected changes in the New Education Policy and a seminar should conveniently be organized.
